“BOLLYWORM” (BOLLYWOOD QUIZ)



Phase – I (Elimination Round)

1. Each team should consist of two participants.
2. There will be a written test for all the participating teams.
3. The written test will consist of 30 multiple choice questions.
4. Time duration for the test will be 15 minutes.
5. Questions will be related to Hindi feature films.
6. Top 5 teams will be selected on the basis of points they have gained in Phase-I.

Phase – II (Final Round)

1. In Phase-II there will be 5 rounds.
2. The final winner will be decided on the basis of overall performance of the team in Phase – II.

Guidelines for the game

- A team should consist of 2-3 members.

- A theme will be given to all team on the day of event and they have to design T-shirt according to the given theme.
- Painting must be creative, clear and related to the theme. The theme will be given on the spot.
- Time duration will be one hour and half an hr for drying after submission.
- The painting size should be 8x10 inch.
- If painting contents violates any of the rules of the contest they will be considered as disqualified from the contest.
- Participants cannot use any kind of digital or printed material for designing idea.

Guidelines for the game

1. The team should consist of maximum 2 participants.
2. Participants have to create a rangoli using a theme of their choice.
3. The colours and other material required for the rangoli as per the selected theme have to be brought by the participants.
4. Paints are not allowed.
5. Rangoli has to be made by hand and any type of tools will not be allowed.
6. The maximum time duration will be 1.5 hours, and the rangoli area per team will be 3x3 feet.
7. Teams exceeding the time limit will be disqualified.

Guidelines for the game

1. It is an individual event and an Institute can send more than one participant
2. The participant has to bring his/her own camera for the photography and mobile phones are not allowed for photography.
3. The camera should have a memory card which will be formatted by the judges before the commencement of the event.
4. The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the judges in 2:30 hours and they have to give caption to all the photographs at the time of submission.
5. Mixing, matching or morphing of photographs and the use of software such as Photoshop will not be permitted.
6. The organizers will have all rights for the use of these pictures as and when they deem fit.
7. Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (I) IMPACT, (II) COMPOSITION, (III) TECHNICAL QUALITY and (IV) SUITABILITY for the specific theme.
8. The additional instructions will be announced on the spot.

9. Schedule for elimination round will be communicated to the participants after closing the registration.
10. The quality of performance should be at the dignity of their institute.
